




Counter Terrorism Advice

Heading out to watch the game? Security is a team effort. When you're out and about, be aware of your surroundings. Report anything that doesn't feel right to security, the police or <u>Report</u> <u>terrorist or extremist content online – Action Counters Terrorism</u> In an emergency call 999.

Are you, or someone you know at risk of Domestic Abuse?



Clare's Law is the Domestic Violence Disclosure Scheme which allows you to ask about the information police hold on a person in relation to domestic abuse offences and convictions so you can assess if they pose any risk.

Seasonal Crime Prevention Advice

- Keep presents and valuables out of sight.
- Dispose of all boxes and packaging carefully, particularly from expensive presents, and do not leave it on show outside the house.
- Register valuables and gifts for free on the National Property Register Database <u>immobilise.com</u> which enables police to identify the owner of valuables if they are stolen and return them.

If a family member or friend makes an unusual request via WhatsApp or text, always call the person to confirm their identity (try their usual mobile number or landline first).
